

## Publishing rules for BCE-Publications

The article **cannot infringe the copyright of third parties.**

Texts sent to the editors **cannot be previously published or submitted elsewhere.**

Submitting the text, the author consents to: any stylistic changes resulting from the standard language and to make any necessary changes to the content arrangement (in order to improve the readability of the text), and also to use it to be printed or in electronic publications. The author transfers **the copyright** on the Editorial Board.

The author declares that the submitted texts are written in accordance with the principles of scientific integrity and without the occurrence of ghostwriting and guest authorship phenomena.

All materials included in the Publication are **protected by copyright.** Reproduction of the text can occur only with the consent of the editors.

### Notes on the preparation of the text

- **the length of the text:** 30,000 to 50,000 characters (including spaces, footnotes and literature reference list). Any exceptions to the rules must be discussed with the editors;
- **languages:** German and/or English;
- the text should **include subtitles**;
- **abstract:** 150 to 250 words in English or in German (will be translated);
- **keywords:** 4 to 6 in English and/or German, separated with a semicolon;
- **citations:** they should be put into quotation marks;
- **references:** they should be put in the main text, not in the footnotes. The name of the author, the year of publication and pages should be written in parentheses, e.g. (Habermas 2008, 10);
- **list of references:** the full description of the reference should be put in alphabetical order at the end of the article, using the comma record.

*in case of a monograph:*

- surname, name initial(s), title of the publication, place and year of publishing, pages.

*in case of an article of collective work:*

- surname, name initial(s), title of the article, [in]: name initial(s), surname of the editor, title of the collective publication, place and year of publishing, pages.

*in case of an article in the journal:*

- surname, name initial(s), title of the article, title of the journal in quotation marks, year of publishing, volume, number, pages.

*in case of referring to a website:*

- surname, name initial(s), title of the article, full internet address of the article, date of entry in the format: (dd.mm.rrrr).

*in case of legal documents:*

e.g.: The Act of 4 February 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights, Journal of Laws of 1994 No 24 item 83 amended, article

- **biographical note:** a few sentences about the author; affiliation and titles of few significant publications are necessary, e-mail address form author(s).

**Accepted file formats:** \*.odt, \*.doc, \*.docx, \*.rtf (others are possible after prior arrangement with the technical editor).

**Accepted graphic formats:** \*.eps, \*.ps, \*.jpeg, \*.png, \*.gif, \*.bmp (others are possible after prior arrangement with technical editor) in minimum resolution of 300 dpi.
